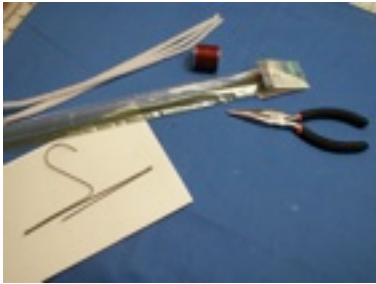


# How to make a doll clothes hanger

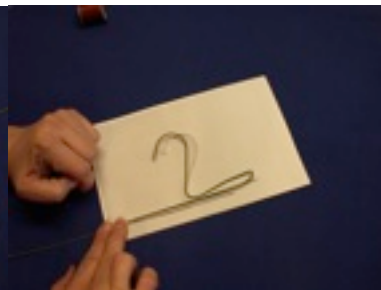
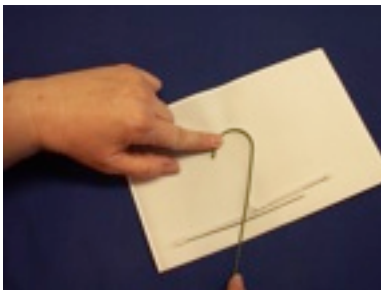


You will need:

1. Hanger template
2. 16 gauge stem wire 18" long
3. spool of thread
4. needle nose pliers
5. 3 pipe cleaners 12" long



Wrap one end of the wire about half way around the spool of thread to make a hook.

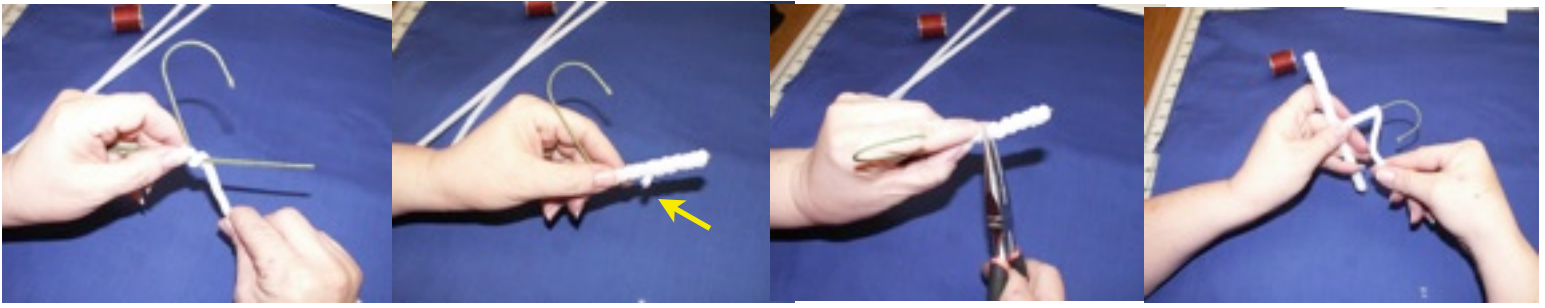


Place the wire on the template and bend the wire at each point.



Crimp the end bends with the pliers so they are nice and flat.

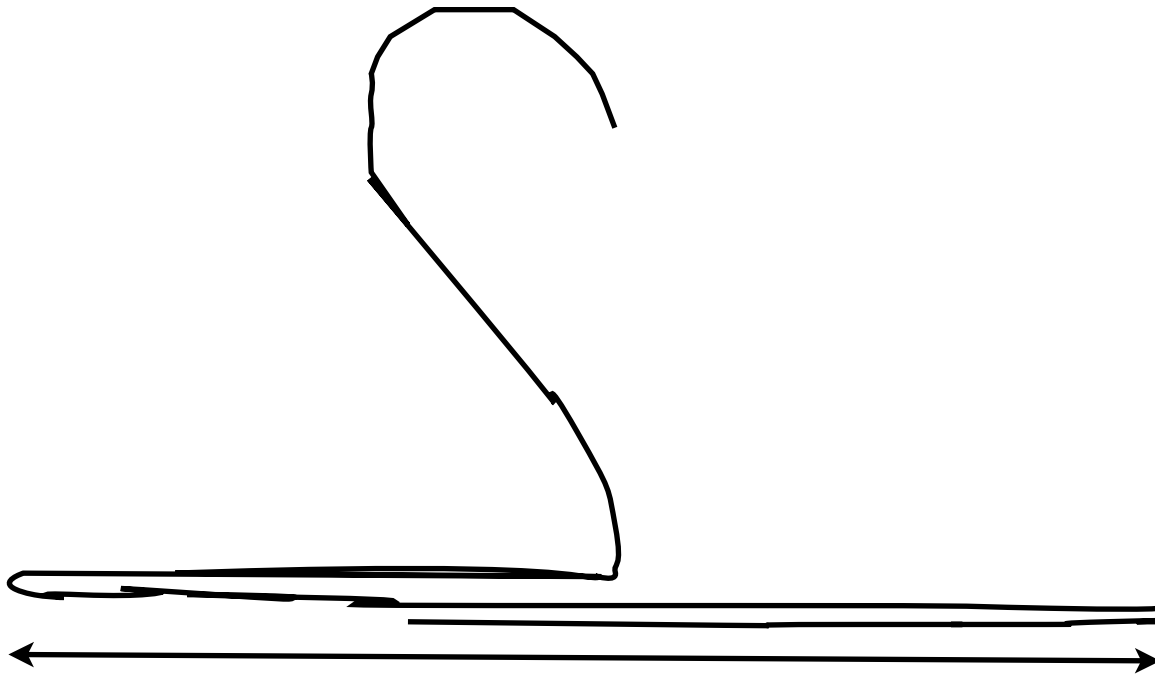
Once you've bent this first wire, save it and use it as your template. It's much easier to use this as a template than the paper.



Wrap one pipe cleaner around one of the “arms” starting from the center and working your way out toward the end. Get as close to the end as you can then come back the other direction to wrap over itself. Crimp the loose end in so there are no sharp points. Take the second pipe cleaner and wrap the other arm the same way. Take the third pipe cleaner and wrap it around the hook. Make sure you crimp in all loose ends.



Bend the “arms” down slightly if you like.



Six inches from one end to the other
